

Income support

Income support is temporary financial assistance. The goal is for you to be able to support yourself through salary or other income.



Who can receive income support?

You may be entitled to income support if you have made every effort you can to support yourself, but still not able to meet your basic needs.

The right to support is assessed on an individual basis.



What criteria do I need to fulfill in receiving income support?

If you are unemployed, you must actively be looking for work, participate in the interventions brought forth by the Employment Agency and be available on the labor market.

If you are ill, you must provide a current medical certificate. In the first place, the right to sickness benefit must be examined.




How much money will I receive?

The government sets a so-called national standard every year. The national standard specifies how much money different households may receive.

If there are special reasons, the income support can be calculated at a higher or lower level, compared to the national standard.

Income support

For what can I get income support for?

You can get income support for:

- food
- clothes and shoes
- consumables
- play and leisure
- health and hygiene
- daily newspaper, telephone

You can also receive income support for reasonable costs for housing, electricity, home insurance, healthcare, eye glasses, dental care, broadband, unemployment contributions, union fee, etc.



How do I apply for income support?

Applications for income support are made via the self-service portal on Ljusdal municipality's website, ljusdal.se. There you also have it in printable paper form for the application. Paper forms for the application can also be picked up from income support at Hotellgatan 6 in Ljusdal.

The application is done on a monthly basis.
